Police officers are very often the first responders to serious accidents and dangerous incidents, which can sometimes result in the unthinkable happening. Support from the Trust can provide a degree of financial certainty in difficult times and is provided for on or off duty incidents to families of officers from forces in the north of England, North Wales and Scotland who donate to the Trust.

Our support can include:

- Registration Grant
- Weekly Support Allowance for each child in the family
- Seasonal Gifts
- Further Education Grants
- Ex-gratia Grants for necessary activities or items
- Special Needs Grant
- One week's Respite Week at our Holiday Home in Harrogate and any subsequent visits at discounted rates.
