Legal update provided on all outstanding cases (both employment and discipline)

ND updated the meeting that in 2014 our annual spend had risen from £65,000 to just over £165,000. ND was pleased however this increase was effectively managed within the General Account and there was no requirement to go into any of our reserves.

This investment in protecting our members interests in some crucial areas of employment will demonstrate over time a extremely valuable investment in the protection of our members employment rights.

ND, highlighted the need that when we enter the judicial arena with our legal advisors support and counsel, we shall only commence the process when all other avenues have been exhausted and the challenge is the right route to follow.

Action

Pensions - The CNPF Executive shall continue to press both DECC Ministers and the employer CNPA to identify

The Executive shall continue to lobby for a retirement age of 60 for CNPF Federated ranks .

(Subsequent to meeting positional statements requested and potential judicial review of the pension age issue being explored with our legal advisors .)

Action

Pay and Conditions The CNPF Negotiating Team are directed and reminded of the direction of Conference in 2008 , to strive for a settlement that provides "equality of salary" of our Home Office and Scottish Government Police Service colleagues

Action.

During Mr Peter Storeys absence Mrs Louise Paton has agreed to in the interim period until Mr Storey returns to take an overview of the CNPF finance. Day to Day financial management will remain at the Federation Office in Warrington.

Action

The Executive are committed in investing in training for its representatives.

To that end it as been agreed that we shall approach both PFEW and SPF with a view to have nominated representatives trained as "Police Friends"

We understand that whilst the CNPF has trained Police Friends to advocacy level,we have identified the requirement to train more of our representatives in this area.

Action

30 Day Business Account. Approval provided to transfer surplus funds to our investment brokers .

(Subsequent to this meeting we have gone through due diligence with the investment brokers St James Place and shall make an initial investment of £30,000. The Trustees have been involved with meetings with representatives of the brokers. At the present time the intention is still to maintain a certain and substantial amount of surplus in the 30 day business account, and to review further investments regularly.)

Action

The Executive provided full support and encouragement to the CNPF chairman to pursue the candidature to the position of Treasurer or Auditor of EuroCOP.

If successful in this election he will be fully supported throughout his term of office by the CEO and the other Executive officers of the CNPF.
