Withdrawal from Operational Sites.

The CNPF Executive, along with our legal advisors are closely monitoring the CNC's stance regarding the deployment of the non-AFOs at various sites. The CNPF executive will continue to assess the situation and will take all appropriate and necessary steps, including any legal challenge(s) in order to protect their members' interests. The CNPF will keep you advised of any developments as and when they occur.

Futures

For the avoidance of any doubt, the salary and conditions of service review known as "Futures" has yet to be brought forward for consultation and negotiation by our employers the CNPA. It is our understanding that this matter is still within the Ministerial approval route. We have indicated to both the CNC Executive and the Chair of the Police Authority, that we would welcome this matter be pushed back whilst other pressing matters such as the withdrawal from Operational site
