All Members should be reassured that all appropriate and legitimate legal remedies are being actively explored by your Police Federation and its lawyers, and we are determined to protect our member's employment rights in this matter and to have them treated with the dignity we had hoped the employer should have adopted. Hopefully constructive dialogue can continue with the employer representatives before others outside the direction and control of the CNPA/CNC have to become actively involved in this matter. As I am sure you can appreciate a lot of these matters are subject to legal privilege .
