We have been advised that the project working on Civil Nuclear Police Officers pay and conditions of service ( Futures ) since 2010 is an effect been placed back at square one by the CNPA/CNC sponsoring body the Department of Energy and Climate Change ( DECC).

In our view “Futures” is now in the past. The CNPA & the CNC Executive really need to reflect how much more time and energy and the use of the public purse they are going to sacrifice during this period of austerity on this project.

Whilst the recently published Tom Winsor’s recommendations on Police Officers Pay and conditions of service to the Home Secretary which are currently being adopted in England and Wales are unpalatable in some areas, it does provide our employer with a structure and platform of Police Officer pay and conditions of service in which we could commence consultation and negotiation on.

We shall through the channels available to us make representations to the relevant Government Minister in regard to this matter. It is important that all parties in this process start to make real progress in this area of pay and conditions of service for Civil Nuclear Police Officers
