By now we trust you all have had the opportunity to read and reflect on the positional statement provided by the Chief Constable in relation our request to be provided with a “ Futures update, following the meetings we were aware that had taken place between the CNPA/CNC and DECC.

This program of work on terms and conditions for federated ranks which is currently known as “Futures” and which commenced in 2010 has clearly now moved into a new framework, and in our view and that of our advisors this demonstrates small, positive and measurable progress.

Clearly there is still much work to do, and we have no doubt that along this journey the employer and ourselves will have our differences, but that’s what makes teams pull together effectively. Please be assured that your Police Federation has the moral fortitude, not to accept any formula in relation our terms and conditions of employment that is not in our view and that of our professional advisors in our member’s best interest.
