



AGREEMENT BETWEEN CNC & CNPF re: DECP Operations

This agreement will apply only to the DECP Operation and will not apply to any other operation where the Civil Nuclear Constabulary is deployed.

1. Background.

An operation involving officers from the Civil Nuclear Constabulary and Police Service of Scotland is currently being planned.

Due to the remote location of the operations, and given the frequency of deployments, there is insufficient suitable local hotel accommodation to meet the needs of the CNC.

The DEC Programme has proposed that "Bunkabin" accommodation will be utilised to accommodate both CNC and PSoS officers for the duration of each operation. This accommodation will be physically situated within the boundary of the site. The "Bunkabin" accommodation does not meet all of the CNC's normal standards of accommodation.

CNC officers utilising this accommodation will be confined to the limits of the site for the duration of the operation. This will mean that for the duration of each operation officers will not be able to undertake the normal activities associated with free rest time and will in effect mean that for the duration of each operation officers will be classed as either on duty or in a state that they are immediately ready to resume duty.

It is also proposed that Police Service of Scotland Officers involved in the operation will be accommodated in the same standard of accommodation.

2. Officers Entitlements

Utilising the option of the "Bunkabin", a "Hardship Allowance" will be paid to officers as detailed below for each 24 hour period:

2a. Rostered duty = 12 hours plain time (normal 12 hour duty salary cost)

2b. Standby duty = 4 hours TX1/3

2c. NTO Allowance = paid for the 12 hour off- duty period within 24 hours

2d. Overnight allowance = Paid for each overnight stay and meal allowances are allowed to and from operational venue in accordance with CNPA terms & conditions relating to travel & subsistence.

2e. An enhanced rate of NTO allowance be payable to Inspecting ranks taking account of their specific T&Cs regarding overtime payments.

2f. Overtime will only be paid for operational duty, it will not be claimed by officers while they are off duty, but still within the operational area.

3. Officer Conditions

3a. All food and dietary requirements will be met and supplied both on and off duty, notice will be given to the provider prior to operational deployment

3b. Clean bedding & towels will be provided.

3c. Clean mattresses will be provided

3d. A drying facility or storage area will be provided for wet kit.

3e. 'Bunkabins' will be cleaned prior to new occupancy.

3f. There are no laundering facilities, officers will be supplied with sufficient kit for the duration of the operation.

3g. Officers will be required to maintain a standard of cleanliness that is expectant of a member of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary.
