### FOI Request from the Civil Nuclear Police Federation

Thank you for your email of 7<sup>th</sup> January 2016, where you requested the following:

“Please can we provided with the DECC Ministerial (Parliamentary under Secretary of State, Baroness Sandip Verma) submission that makes the case for an exemption for Civil Nuclear Police Authority under section 10 of the Public Services Pension Act 2013, to maintain a pension and retirement age of 60 for operational officers given the nature of the role and that of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary.

We believe this submission was made between June and July 2014.

Can we also be provided with the response received by DECC from HMG Treasury in relation to the submission”
