Thank you for your letter of 2 December 2016, addressed to Baroness Neville-Rolfe. I understand that Baroness Neville-Rolfe had the opportunity to meet with you and your colleagues on 3 November, helping her to further understand the concerns of your members. As you may be aware I am now the minister responsible for civil nuclear. I apologise for the delay in replying.

I am grateful for the information on costs submitted by the Deputy Chief Constable following on from your meeting. My officials are reviewing this information and engaging with the CNC on this matter. Please be assured that I will review all evidence submitted by you and the CNC before taking a decision on whether to seek a change in Government policy on pension age for CNC officers.

I am aware the CNC have submitted their application for admission to the scheme, for which I am grateful. This ensures that the CNC is compliant with the requirements of the Public Service Pensions Act 2013. I also acknowledge your concerns about the Infrastructure Policing Review; as yet no decision has been made on this.

The subject of increased pension age is an issue with implications for your members. I will continue to review all the evidence submitted by all parties before taking a decision on this matter.

Thank you again for contacting us. I therefore look forward to continuing to work with you in the future.
